A SUMMER OF WONDER

This year's summer program centers on wonder and exploration! Children will engage in open-ended experiences that invite them to investigate materials, ask questions, and follow their curiosity through play. Throughout the summer, children may explore light and shadow, loose parts, water, natural materials, and movement in ways that feel meaningful. Alongside these explorations, each day will include art, storytelling, music, dramatic play, sprinkler play, and field trips.

Exploring with Light and Shadow

Children may experiment with light, reflection, and shadow using natural and classroom materials, noticing how light changes space, shape, and movement.

Building and Creating with Loose Parts

Open ended materials invite children to construct, combine, take apart, and rebuild, supporting problem solving, collaboration, and imaginative thinking.

Water, Motion, and Sensory Play

Children may explore water through pouring, measuring, movement, and experimentation, asking questions about flow, cause and effect, and change.

Nature, Materials, and Outdoor Inquiry



Using found and natural materials, children may observe, collect, sort, and create, deepening their relationship with the natural world around them.



OUTSIDE TIME

What sets our summer program apart is our private rooftop space. With no need to leave the building, children have access to a safe, spacious environment that combines outdoor adventure, water play, and nature exploration all in one place.


- **The Nature Nook:** A calming space for hands-on nature exploration and discovery

On the rooftop at Chelsea Day School


The Nature Nook is an intentional space on the roof of Chelsea Day School that brings nature into our city environment. It offers children opportunities for hands-on exploration, imaginative play, and sensory inquiry, using loose parts and natural materials to support open-ended discovery. Children are encouraged to engage with the natural world at their own pace, fostering curiosity and inquiry. This thoughtfully designed space also promotes conversations around sustainability and environmental responsibility, complementing our rooftop garden and greenery.


